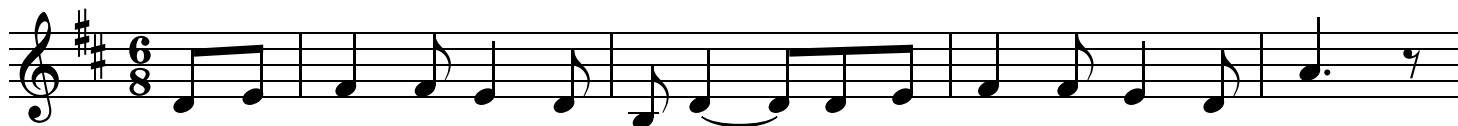

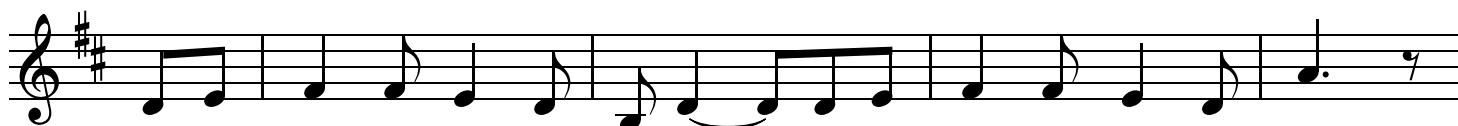
Across the Lands

From each tribe and tongue and na - tion You are lead-ing sin-ners home.

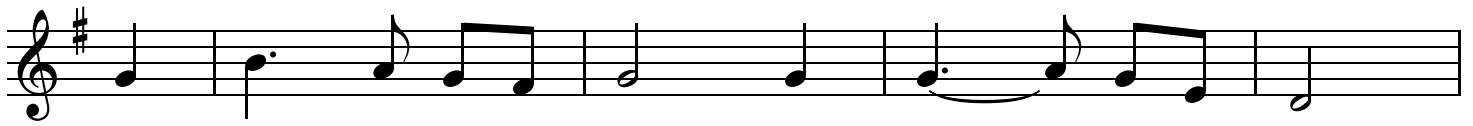

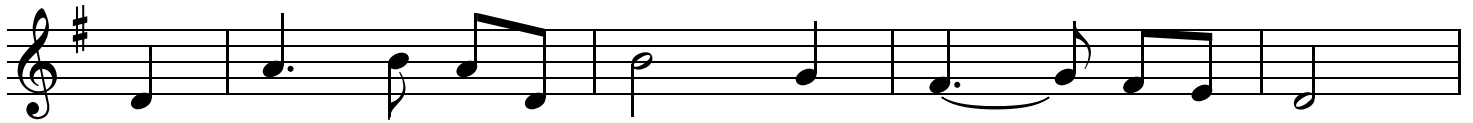
