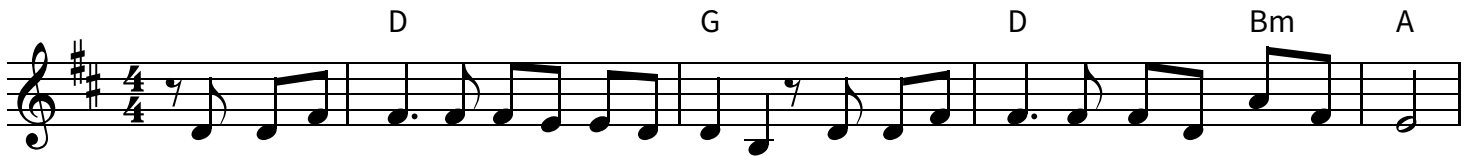

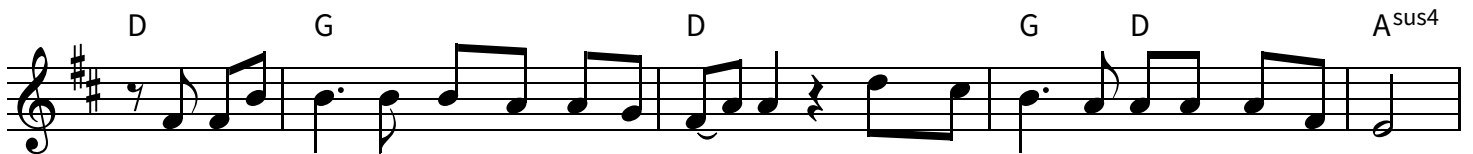
Yet Not I, But Through Christ in Me
