Instructions:

- 1. Please fill out this application neatly, completely, and honestly using blue/black ink.
- 2. Carefully read and consider the Risk Statement below with your parents. There will also be a risk assessment specific to each trip provided by the missions committee.
- 3. Make sure that you and your parents have signed the final page.
- 4. Turn in the application along with a \$100 deposit to Chelsea or leave in the drop box on the WC House porch by **February 23, 2020 (priority application deadline).** Checks should be made payable to FCCH. (If you need more time on your deposit, please let us know in advance of submitting your application.)
- 5. Participants and their parents should attend an important meeting on **Sunday**, **February 23** (please see Chelsea if you will be away for February break). Students will be expected to participate in team meetings on Sundays **March 29**, **April 26**, and **May 17**. Students and their parents are asked to help run the church picnic on **Sunday**, **June 7**. Please mark your calendars now and notify Chelsea with any conflicts ASAP.
- 6. Please note this year's Payment Schedule and Letter-Writing Deadline:

February 9: \$100 deposit and/or scholarship request due upon application **March 22:** Fundraising letters due (a packet with form letters will be provided on February 23) **April 26:** Additional \$100 due for Portland team members; \$200 due for Nassau team members **June 28:** Additional \$100 due for Portland team members; \$250 due for Nassau team members *An alternate payment plan or extension may be worked out upon request. For example, students working to pay for their trip may wish to pay smaller amounts over a longer period of time.

Risk Statement:

While the missions committee of FCCH, in partnership with its partner organizations, will take measures to minimize safety and health risks for trip participants, certain unforeseen incidents can arise and we cannot guarantee safety. Traveling to and working in many countries, and even many US cities, carries inherent risks. These include criminal acts, weather emergencies and health crises. If any of these events should occur, there would also be emotional consequences.

While the missions committee will conduct a risk assessment for each sponsored trip, all participants are encouraged to do their own research and risk review especially with respect to any personal health or other challenges.

All participants are responsible to receive recommended immunizations and vaccinations. Any personal health issues should be disclosed to trip leaders so potential medical treatments can be considered and planned.
