Dropping Objects

Place a pot on the floor. Ask your child/children to choose a hard or soft object, stand in front of the pot, and drop it in. Ask, "Did you hear something?" Encourage your child/children to tell you what they heard. Say, "If you heard something, touch your ear. God made your ears so you can hear things." Repeat as many times as is desired.



Children's Band

Put instruments in a box or basket. Let your child/children choose an instrument. Play songs on a radio, from a cd, on your

phone, on a computer or on a

music channel on TV ... whatever device you choose. As you play songs encourage children to play their instruments. Say, "God made our ears to hear music." Put your hand behind your ear. Say, "I can hear _____ (child's name) playing the _____ ." Say each child's name and name the instrument. Say, "Touch your ears if you can hear music. Thank you, God, for making our ears." Let your child/children walk around the room with instruments or they could follow you in a parade.






