A simple and hilarious story, but not for the sensitive child. *Spoiler*: It doesn't end well for the poor rabbit who stole the hat.




Creepy Carrots, by Peter Brown


The Night Gardner, by Jonathan Auxier


The Strange Case of Origami Yoda, by Tom Angleberger

The Graveyard Book, by Neil Gaiman



Top 4 Young Adult Books




Lord of the Rings, by J.R.R. Tolkien
