

77.6 mi. – about 1 hour 45 min.

- ➤ Take Interstate 95 north into NH
- ➤ Take exit 4 onto NH-16/Spaulding Turnpike/US-4 and continue to follow NH-16/Spaulding Turnpike (partial toll road)
- Take exit 15 off of Route 16 and get onto NH Route 11
- ➤ Stay on Route 11 in to Alton Bay, NH
- ➤ When you see the southern tip of Lake Winnipesaukee in front of you, stay to the left and follow Route 11
- ➤ You will make a turn to the left followed by a quick turn to the right to stay right on the lake front on Route 11
- ➤ After making these two quick turns (the "zig-zag"), look for the Alton Bay Christian Conference Center entrance on your left and turn left and go up the hill to the Conference Center
