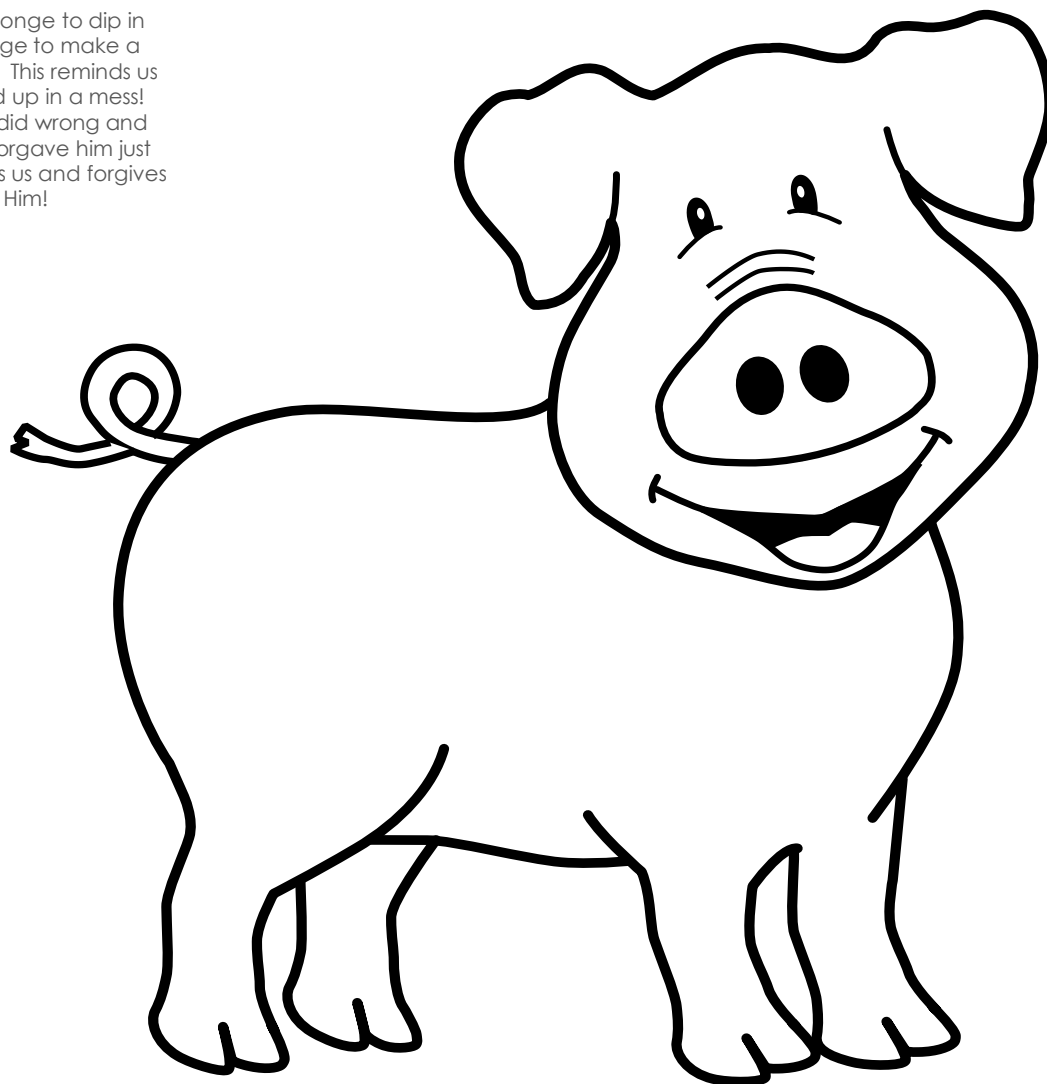

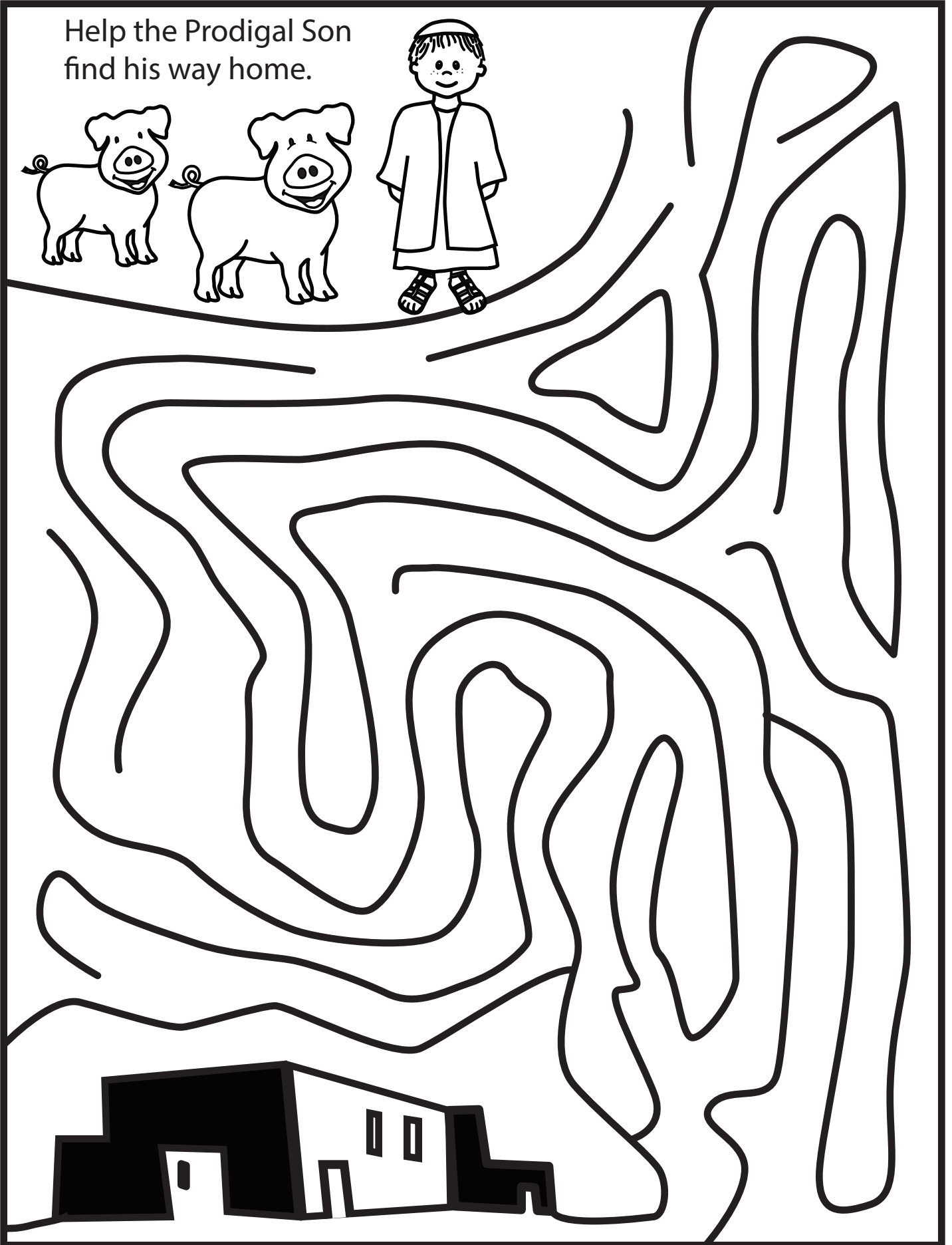
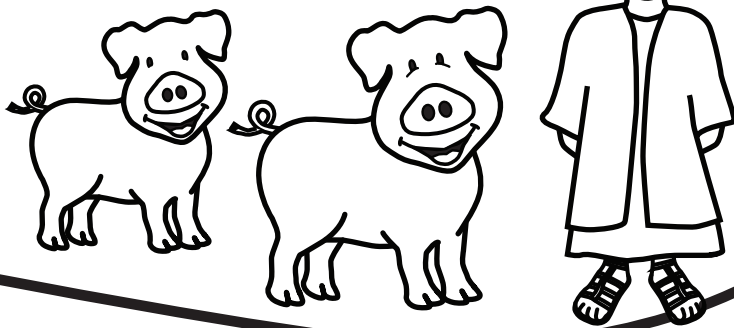


"You, Lord, are forgiving and good, abounding in love to all who call to you." Psalm 86:5, NIV

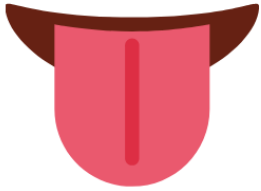

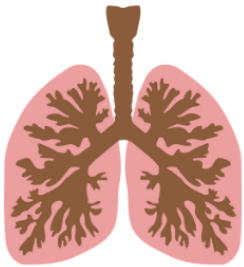
WONDERFULLY MADE VERSE GAME
